In this article, I will be discussing the competitive advantages of exporting Iran's bitumen to Thailand.


In the first step, the price gap between the 2 countries will be investigated.

Having 10% of world bitumen export with high quality, Iran is an attractive market for other role players.

Thailand is a pole of production and export of bitumen in East Asia; however, a large quantity of its demand is supplied from Iran.

High quality, price attraction, and variety in packing are the factors that make Iran's bitumen market appealing.

As you see in the below chart, there is a big gap between bitumen price in Iran and Thailand.



The monthly average of bitumen price (USD/MT) during January to June 2023 in Iran and Thailand is seen in the below table:


The price difference between Iran and Thailand is sometime even up to 200 USD/MT. In this situation, more demand of bitumen purchase from Iran is received from Thailand. Although, Thailand is known as one of the main and biggest producers of bitumen in East Asia, Iran's bitumen production is 4 times more than Thailand. There are 4 main bitumen producing refineries in Thailand:

- 1. Integrate Refinery Petrochemical Complex (IRPC) at Rayong,
- 2. Thai Lube Base (a subsidiary of Thai Oil) in Sriracha,
- 3. Star Petroleum Refining (SPRC) at Map Ta Phut port (Rayong),
- 4. and Esso at Sriracha.

The production capacity of bitumen in the country is annually around 1.364 million Metric Tons.

However, the global economic recession caused by Ukraine war affected the level of production among the refineries all over the world.

In the below chart, you can see the amount of production and consumption in Thailand:

Based on the above chart, the level of production and consumption is as below up to 2024:

Based on these data, it is predicted that bitumen production and consumption in Thailand will increase during 2022-2024.


According to the obtained statistics, the most commonly used grades of bitumen are respectively as follows:

 Conventional grades of bitumen used in Thailand are pen 60/70 and pen 80/100.

- Performance grades used are PG 64, PG 70, PG 76 and PG 82, depending on the climatic conditions.
- PMB and jet fuel resistant modified bitumen (PMB-FR) are also used.
- Bitumen emulsion grades are CRS-1, CRS-2, CMS-2h, CSS-1 and CSS-1h.
- Cutback grades used are MC-30, MC-70, RC-70 and RC-250.
- PMB emulsions used are CSS-1hp, CSS-1h (EMA), CRS1P, CRS-2P, CMS-2hP, CSS-1hN

It can be said that almost all of the abovementioned grades are produced in Iran.

As a main pole of bitumen production in East Asia, Thailand exports a considerable quantity of its bitumen to compete on bitumen price with other countries like Taiwan, Singapore, and South Korea. The tight competition of Thailand with its competitors in East Asia has turned the country to export its bitumen to many of the markets in Asia.




In the below table, the monthly average of bitumen price in different producing countries of East Asia and Thailand can be seen separately.

Thailand exports its bitumen to the countries like: Bangladesh, China, Laos, Malaysia, Philippine, Cambodia, Indonesia, and even Australia.

The below chart demonstrates the rate of bitumen import/export in Thailand up to 2024:

It is predicted that its bitumen export will reach around 335K MT in 2023.

Thailand imports its required bitumen from Iran and Singapore. It is forecasted that Thailand's bitumen import will reach 257K MT in 2024.

Now, we are going to discuss why Iran's bitumen is a good source of import for Thailand and what is the competitive advantage of importing Iran's bitumen?

- 1. Based on the scientific investigations and the available facts, Iran is capable of producing the high-quality bitumen which is easy to recognize from other producers in the region.
- 2. The significant price difference between Iran bitumen price and other manufacturers in south east Asia has made Iran bitumen attractive in terms of its prices.
- 3. Iran bitumen can be supplied in various packings such as new steel drum and jumbo bags with wooden pallet and metal cage.
- 4. Moving bitumen jumbo bags and new steel drums in different regions of Thailand is easier comparing the bulk bitumen and this is a good advantage for the contractors even in the different islands of Thailand.
- 5. The regular services of the shipping lines from Persian Gulf to Bangkok and Laem Chabang is another advantage to receive the product at the destination in the shortest possible time.
- 6. The suitable transit time and receiving the cargo within 4-5 weeks is another favorable advantage for the customers.
- 7. Inspecting cargo by SGS company to certify the bitumen quality thoroughly.



The most appropriate packings of Iran in Thailand market are:

1. Bitumen in jumbo bag 1MT with metal cage and wooden pallet. Being zero waste and eco-friendly, this packing can be definitely a more appropriate

- choice in Thailand market. It should be also noted that this packing is cheaper than the packing of new steel drum.
- 2. Bitumen in new steel drums of 180kg that might not be suggested to be used especially in some of the islands of Thailand due to environmental issues.



One of the main criteria of testifying Iran bitumen quality and comparing it with other manufacturers' is to investigate the full SGS report. It should be noted that many international inspecting companies are working in Iran and SGS is one of them. One of the ways to recognize the high-quality bitumen of Iran from other producers in the region is to test "spot test" as a main item of assessing bitumen quality. If the spot test results negative, it means the bitumen has been produced from pure crude oil and it is known a high-quality bitumen.

I would like to have a brief introduction on some other products which are popular in Thailand market as well:

Base Oil:

During the period January to April 2023, Thailand imported 110,834 MT of base oil.

As per the data analysis by our team, import of the country was down by 9% in comparison of same duration in 2022.

During the period January to April 2023, Thailand exported 88421 MT of base oil. Iran base oil which is mainly imported to Thailand with the origin of UAE has a very high quality and the consumers are attracted to this product of Iran.
